DISABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

Any impairment, including a physical, mental, intellectual, cognitive, learning, communication or sensory impairment – or a functional limitation – whether permanent or episodic in nature, or evident or not, that, in interaction with a barrier, hinders a person's full and equal participation in society.

ELIGIBILITY PERIODS

May 10 - June 6, 2020

June 7 - July 4, 2020

July 5 - August 1, 2020

August 2 - August 29, 2020

ELIGIBILITY

The benefit is being offered to students, new graduates, Canadians studying abroad and high school students who are set to enter post-secondary in the fall.



You are a Canadian Citizen



You are unable to work or cannot find work due to COVID-19 or you are working but your income is **\$1,000** or less during the 4 week period you are applying for



You did not apply, receive, nor qualify, for the CERB or EI benefits for the same eligibility period



You are a post-secondary or recent post-secondary student or a recent high school graduate
